Roll Call/Welcome

New business:

- We have paid out all enrichments/large grants that were approved other than the PE departments chalk for \$196, and whatever we decide to help the orchestra's bus expense for Worlds of Fun.
- We are collecting funds for the 8th grade parents for their breakfast. This is not our money. They have \$2093.35 in our account so far.

 - Final planning for Mav In
 - We have 195 kids signed up right now!!!
- Currently we have collected \$4375 in forms alone from the kids, and \$375 of that is extra to cover the cost of kids that may not be able to come otherwise. We have 213 kids signed up. If you hadn't heard, we decided to keep accepting forms from the kids up until the event date of next Friday. It will still be \$20 a child, \$10 for additional family members, and will go up to \$25 on the Friday of the event. We have plenty of food, prizes, and activities.
- Stacy and Carissa plan to go up to the school on Friday 2-28 during the lunch hour to hopefully spark a little more interest with them again.
- Tentative Schedule for the night of is:
 - 2:35 - Check In in the commons area with their after school snack of hotdog, chips, cookie and a drink, Then we will give them the rundown on what activities and where they are located, and rules and expectations etc.
 - 3 - 5:30 pm - This will be their time for all the activities
 - 4:45 - we will have dinner available for the kids from IHOP, but it will be served as a come and go. They do not have to eat right at 4:45 but it will be shut down at 5:30

- 5:30 - all games and activities will be shut down
- 5:30 - we will have everyone go to the gym for the large prizes giveaway. It was decided tonight, rather than to take up a ton of time playing a game that we don't know how long will take, we will have a table set up with 10 prizes on it. I will print off everyone's name and they will go in a bucket. The first name drawn gets first pick of the prizes on the table, 2nd name drawn gets second pick and so on for 10 names. The prizes for this table are: 50"TV, air pods and a case, chrome book, Nintendo switch lite, google show 5, chicken and pickle package deal, 2 \$25 academy sports gift cards, \$25 amazon gift card, and a \$25 fandango gift card.
